  - ❖ Students will be enrolled in one (1) after school class. Please indicate 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> choice on the class form.
  - ❖ Students may be registered for AM classes and 1 after school class.
  - ❖ Confirmation of enrollment will be sent home with the student the week prior to classes beginning.
  - ❖ **RESPECT IS REQUIRED!** The child receives one warning and a call home to parents. The second offense will result in the child's removal from all remaining classes for that session.
- ❖ If your child will not be able to attend his/her class on a particular day, please email Mark Sepnafski at [msepnafs@wausauschools.org](mailto:msepnafs@wausauschools.org) or send a note with your child indicating the absence or change in plan. Include child's name and after school class in the note.
