Guidelines for Growing Great Minds

- ❖ Parents are welcome to attend any class.
 - ❖ REGISTER ON TIME. Enrollment is limited and classes fill quickly! Every effort will be made to assign your child to the class of their choice.
 - ❖ Students will be enrolled in at least one (1) after school class. Please indicate 1st and 2nd choice on the class form.
 - ❖ AM classes are considered separately.
 - ❖ Confirmation of enrollment will be sent home with the student the week prior to classes beginning.
 - ❖ **RESPECT IS REQUIRED!** The child receives one warning and a call home to parents. The second offense will result in the child's removal from all remaining classes for that session.
- ❖ If your child will not be able to attend his/her class on a particular day, please email Mark Sepnafski at msepnafs@wausauschools.org or send a note with your child indicating the absence or change in plan. Include child's name and after school class in the note.
- ❖ If you sign up for bus transportation, you must contact school if you plan to pick up your child. Your child will go on the bus if a change notice from the parent or guardian is not received.
 - ❖ Dismissal is at 4:30 – please be prompt when picking up your child. A financial charge or program dismissal may be incurred for late pick-up.

G2M Memberships & Sponsorships

G2M (Growing Great Minds) Out-of-School Learning Programs provide a range of high-quality services to support student learning and development, including tutoring and mentoring, homework help, academic enrichment (such as hands-on science or technology programs), community service opportunities, as well as music, arts, sports, and cultural activities. At the same time, centers help working parents by providing a safe environment for students. The following schools have out-of-school enrichment programs: Lincoln, Hawthorn, Riverview, Grant, Thomas Jefferson, Stettin, GD Jones, John Muir and Horace Mann. John Marshall and Montessori may offer a few classes in the 2018-19 school year as well.

The cost for membership is \$5 per year per child, or \$10 maximum per family. This is not intended to be a barrier to participation. Families are asked to pay, **if they are able**. At the elementary level, this membership fee will cover full participation in G2M on the registration program and at the middle school level will cover enrichment activities such as, but not limited to EXTREME Robotics, Full Body Fitness, Computer Coding, Yoga, Jig Making, and Pay It Forward/Leadership Club. Whether your child attends one class or several, this is a one-time annual fee. Please note that this membership fee is separate from and should not be confused with any athletic fees, membership fees for outside community agencies or other site-specific special programs or events. It also does not include costs for summer programs. We will continue to offer tutorial or teacher recommended academic programs free of charge. A schedule of class offerings and registration is handled at the individual sites.
