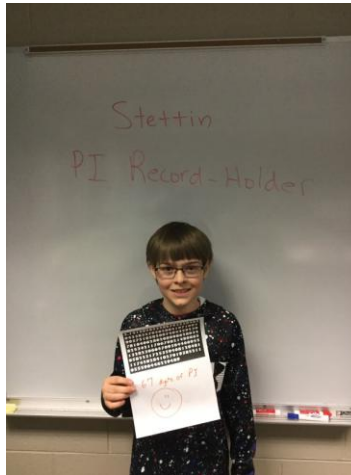

Breakfast

We accept cash or checks for tickets and breakfast. Checks can be made payable to *Stettin School PTO*. We do not accept credit or debit cards. We will have gluten-free pancakes available!

Tech Ticket (ivory) and Regular Raffle Ticket (Yellow) sales

Please return all sold and unsold tickets to the school office by the end of this week. Any remaining tickets will be available for purchase the day of the event. These tickets will only be sold until they are gone. We will not be ordering additional tickets or copying extras. Tech tickets sell for \$5.00 each or 6 for \$25.00. Regular raffle tickets sell for \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00.

We have over 100 prizes to raffle off including: gift cards to various restaurants and local businesses, health and wellness items, Milwaukee Brewers ticket vouchers, bikes, water park passes, Sawmill Adventure Park passes, and so much more! Our tech ticket prizes include: a Nintendo Switch, a 55" Sony TV, a Fitbit Charge 3, a trail camera, and Beats Headphones. Please keep in mind that the tech raffle is separate from the regular raffle.

Day-of-the-Event Raffles
